Program contents, teaching methods and assessment tools are updated in line with student feedback, sectoral developments and scientific research.
- **Research is conducted to develop and implement innovative and effective teaching methods, techniques and technologies to enrich students' learning experience.** Supportive programs, workshops and seminars are organized to improve students' academic achievement and to provide easy access to course materials and additional resources.
- **Efforts are made to maximize the quality of education by supporting the continuous development of faculty members.** In this direction, trainings and seminars are organized to support their professional development and ensure that they follow innovations, taking into account the feedback from faculty members.
- **Regular monitoring and evaluation is carried out to ensure quality assurance of education and training processes.** The studies conducted and the results obtained are regularly reported and shared with the relevant units. Compliance with standards is ensured through practices such as surveys, observations, exam analysis and accreditation processes.
