



ISTANBUL BEYKENT UNIVERSITY INTERNATIONALIZATION POLICY

The Internationalization Policy of Istanbul Beykent University aims to enhance the institution's international presence in alignment with its mission and vision. In this context, the university develops international strategic partnerships, establishes close relationships with institutions, universities, and industrial organizations, and promotes scientific-academic collaborations. Through student and staff exchange programs, it ensures that stakeholders experience cultural diversity and interact with different cultures. Additionally, the university values the sharing of knowledge and experience by international faculty members through exchange programs.

The objectives shaped within the framework of the Internationalization Policy adopted by Istanbul Beykent University are as follows:

- 1.** Establishing strategic partnerships and collaborations internationally, strengthening the university's academic network and global position, thereby increasing its international recognition and visibility.
- 2.** Expanding international research networks and supporting scientific research activities at an international level by encouraging participation in academic studies on a global scale.
- 3.** Enhancing the number of accredited programs within the university by conducting international accreditation processes, aiming for the international recognition of educational programs.
- 4.** Providing internal stakeholders with opportunities for education and research abroad, enhancing their academic and cultural interaction and promoting global knowledge sharing.
- 5.** Supporting international students in their educational process by organizing language and culture programs that facilitate their adaptation to the university.

6. Fostering an inclusive campus environment that supports cultural diversity, encouraging students to interact with different cultures and live together in a socially diverse community.
7. Ensuring the sustainability of the mechanisms within the institution to increase the effectiveness and efficiency of the Internationalization Policy by maintaining their activities with the "plan, do, check, act" managerial cycle.

Evaluations are made to monitor the realization of these objectives, and corrective and continuous improvement measures are taken when necessary.
